

CAMP BELKNAP VISITOR POLICY

We look forward to seeing you at camp! Please review the following policies prior to your visit.

Off Season: September (after Labor Day) to June 5th

- Visitors are welcome on Belknap property during daylight hours. No overnight visitors are allowed.
- Visitors are encouraged to reach out prior to visiting camp.

 - Please note, there may be some dates where we will restrict access due to off-season programming.
- We ask that all visitors check in at Clark Lodge (Main Office).
 - If the office is not open, please sign in using the logbook outside the main door.
- There are no bathrooms or water fountains available in camp during the off season as the water is turned off. During office hours, you are welcome to use the bathroom in Clark Lodge. Otherwise, you will need to plan ahead prior to visiting.
- We have many off-season projects going on. Please be mindful of your surroundings and avoid construction and large equipment.
- Please do not use program equipment or watercrafts. No swimming is allowed.
- If you choose to bring your pet, please clean up after them and keep them leashed.

During Camp Season: June 5th- September (Labor Day)

- Visitors are welcome on Belknap property 8am-6pm.
 - **Guardians are not permitted to visit while their camper is attending camp.**
 - We are unable to give tours but will provide you with a map as a guide.
 - Please do NOT visit camp on camper check-in and check-out days. These dates are posted on the camper page of our website.

- For safety, **all visitors are required to check in and out at Clark Lodge** to receive a visitor badge and any necessary instructions. Badges must be worn at all times.
- Important rules while on camp:
 - Please use the bathroom in Clark Lodge or off-site prior to entering camp. Bathroom use for campers and staff only.
 - No use of cell phones while in camp.
 - Please leave all pets at home.
 - Any children in your group must be supervised at all times.
 - You may enter all “open” program buildings (lodges, dining, craft shop, etc.) while staying out of the way of the activities. Please do NOT enter divisional/living spaces (such as cabins or bathrooms).

For all visitors, at all times:

- Please do not use program equipment or watercrafts, except for ping pong. This equipment is for campers only.
- No swimming allowed.
- No fires, alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances, fireworks, guns, knives, hatchets.
