

CAMP BELKNAP VISITOR POLICY

We look forward to seeing you on camp! Please review the following policies prior to your visit.

Off Season: September (after Labor Day) to June 5th

- Visitors are welcome on Belknap property during daylight hours. No overnight visits.
- Visitors are encouraged to give camp advanced notice by reaching out prior.

 - Please note, there may be some dates where we will restrict access or change to in season rules depending on the off season program(s).
- We ask that all visitors check in at Clark Lodge.
 - If office is not open please sign in the logbook outside.
- There are no bathrooms or water fountains available in camp off season as water is off. Please use the bathroom in Clark Lodge or off site if visiting when the office is not open.
- We have many off-season projects going on. Please be mindful of your surroundings and avoid construction and large equipment.
- See below for program use/restrictions.
- If you bring your pet on camp please pick up after them and keep them leashed or on close command.

During Camp Season: June 5th-Sept (Labor Day)

- Visitors are welcome on Belknap property 8am-6pm. *Please note a couple important things about visiting: Guardians are not permitted to visit while current camper is on site to allow us to meet our mission. For prospective families we do not give tours but can set you up with a map. And finally we request you avoid check-in and out times for visiting.*

- For safety, **all visitors are required to check in and out at Clark Lodge** to receive a visitor badge and any necessary instructions. Badges must be worn at all times.
- Important rules while on camp:
 - Please use the bathroom in Clark Lodge or off site prior to entering camp. Bathroom use for campers and staff only. Potable water is available via spicket outside all bathroom centers.
 - No use of cell phones in camp. We are a tech free camp – please leave in your car or silence in your pocket.
 - No pets on camp. Please make other arrangements.
 - Any children in your group must be supervised at all times.
 - You may enter all “open” program buildings (Lodges, Dining, Crafts shop, etc) while staying out of the way of the activities. And may enter divisional/living spaces (such as cabins or bathrooms) ONLY when no other persons are in them or invited by staff who is present. Please knock prior to entry. Do not enter any area that says “closed.”

For all visitors at all times:

- Please do not use program equipment or water crafts except for ping pong. This equipment is prepared/used by campers.
- No swimming allowed.
- No fires, alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances, fireworks, guns, knives, hatches.
