

Camp Belknap Refund Policy
Updated March 22, 2021

The following information serves to update you regarding refund policies for Camp Belknap in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.

As previously stated in the 2021 Belknap Information and Policies:

The \$150 registration fee that was due at the time of registration is non-refundable. **Payment is due in full by May 1, 2021.** If full payment is not received by May 1 you will be responsible for a \$150 late fee and we cannot guarantee your camper's spot. No refunds will be issued after May 1, including if your camper leaves for any reason (voluntary or not) during a session. There is a \$32.50 fee for any checks returned due to insufficient funds. If you choose to pay the tuition balance with a credit card, a processing fee will be added to the tuition balance due.

Belknap is making an exception to this policy that is outlined below for the 2021 Summer season.

You are now eligible for a FULL tuition refund (less the \$150 non-refundable registration fee):

- If your camper tests positive for COVID 30 days prior to the start of their session or the first day of camp. You must present camp with documentation of a positive test result.
- If your camper has a close contact with a person with COVID within 14 days prior to the starting date of the session. You must present camp with documentation of notification or a test result.
- If Belknap is unable to operate your scheduled session due to COVID and Belknap is unable to reschedule.

You are now eligible for a PRO-RATED tuition refund:

- If during camp your camper is sent home due to a COVID positive test or due to a close contact (cabin mate) with a camper/staff with a positive test. The refund will be based on the number of days the camper was unable to attend.

Please note you are not eligible for a refund after May 1 for any other reasons not listed including inability to travel to camp and change in plans.
